The GRI (Global Reporting Initiative) and ESRS (European Sustainability Reporting Standards) partnership has resulted in a draft [GRI-ESRS Interoperability Index](#).

The tool sets out how the disclosure requirements and data points in each set of standards relate to each other.

See GRI 305: Emissions 2016 and how it relates to ESRS E1 Climate Change and ESRS E2 pollution for reporting.




